Summarised Discussion Points

2	<p>Cat - might run away. Parrot - Needs a very big cage.</p> <p>Tortoise - can carry nasty viruses. Rabbits - can be easily frightened.</p> <p>Caterpillar - wouldn't stay in place long.</p> <p>Hamsters - can bite and tend to come out at night.</p> <p>Mrs H - best bet would be a Guinea pig. - 2 so they can live in pairs. They live 4-8 years. What happens at weekends or holidays?</p>
3	<p>We would need to register with a vet. Would it stay over weekends.</p> <p>Sometimes their teeth can overgrow. People don't tend to have allergies with cats. If it escapes, doors closed in room to keep secure.</p> <p>Lessons for Cat - Learning to look after, support for children who are sad.</p>
